



ENGAGE Project 2014-2016
Short Term Trainings, February, 2016

The three ENGAGE Sectorial CSR-kits will be introduced and tested respectively in each partner's organisation (except in Portugal), at internal level with 10 key-staff during the national training session. The aim of the training session is to introduce the ENGAGE self-assessment tool and the Sectorial CSR-kit, to 10 internal staff (60 in total), in order to create more awareness on CSR and an organisational culture in TR (2), AT, ES, BG and RO. The added value of these short-term joint staff training events is to create more awareness on CSR and an organisational culture and promote professional skills development.

The Short-term joint staff training events will use the adapted training materials and the methodology that will be the final combination of the prepared 3 CSR kits, with contribution and support of the partners. The methodological approach of the short term joint training also ought to be interactive as the practical implementation will indicate which exercises and materials are successful and which do not exactly correspond to the needs of the participants and need to be further adopted or improved.

One 'short-term joint staff training' workshop was conducted in each participant country (except Portugal). As a result of this short term activities, each country will do one report with feedback and recommendations of the participants on the materials (CSR kits).
